Recipient will be a declared, second-year Toyota T-TEN student at Weber State University currently completing an internship in the service department of one of the following Utah Toyota dealerships: Brent Brown Toyota, Ensign Toyota, Karl Malone Toyota, Larry H. Miller Toyota, Mark Miller Toyota, Menlove Toyota, or Tony Divino Toyota.

Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0. Scholarship money can be used for tuition, fees, associated internship travel expenses, books and on-campus housing. No other expenses of any kind are to be paid with this scholarship.

If an award recipient transfers out of the program during the award period or is enrolled for less than full-time credit, the recipient will relinquish all rights to the balance of the award.

Applicants must attach:

1. A brief typewritten essay describing accomplishments while at WSU, how their degree in Automotive Service Technology will be used after graduation, and why they believe they're deserving of the scholarship.
2. A brief statement and/or documentation about financial resources, including a list of other scholarships and tuition waivers being received (say no other scholarships or waivers if that is the case).
3. A copy of the most recent WSU transcript.

Applicants must be enrolled as a second-year student in the Toyota T-TEN program at WSU at the time of application and express intent to earn an Associate of Applied Science Degree.

Applicants will be judged on:

- perceived potential for success in the field of automotive service.
- Progress through Toyota T-TEN program (on track with general education courses)
- excellence of academic record (minimum GPA of 3.0).
- financial need.

I understand that this is not a scholarship offer, but only an application to be considered in scholarship competition if minimum qualifications for the award have been satisfied. I understand that withholding requested information or falsification of this information may result in denial or loss of scholarship.
