QUALIFICATIONS

To be eligible for the 2025-2026 “Introduction to Honors” scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be enrolled full-time in the 2025-26 academic year (at least 12 credit hours per semester);
- Be enrolled in the Foundations Pathway Honors Program before applying;
- Take an Honors course in the 2025-26 academic year.
