Institutional Area (IA)

- 1. First-Year Seminar Course:
 - Consider the development of a first-year seminar course that focuses on essential college skills. The Institutional Area (IA) could be a suitable option for implementing this requirement for all students.

First-Year Experience (FYE)

1. Retention Rates:

 Current retention rates stand at 60%, with a recent increase of 5%. However, the institution is experiencing a total loss of approximately 1,600 students after their first-year.

2. High School Engagement:

• Introducing FYE courses within the high school environment could potentially increase student enrollment at Weber State University.

General Education (GE) Courses

- 1. Course Complexity:
 - Reduce the complexity of course options available to students. Simplifying choices can help students make decisions more efficiently and avoid confusion.

2. Faculty Intentionality:

• Ensure that GE courses are taught by faculty who are intentional in their roles to enhance the quality and relevance of the educational experience.
