Application Deadline: Priority Deadline May 15th; Final Deadline: August 15th. **Program Begins: Each Fall Semester** If you can check each of the left-hand blanks, you are qualified to apply to the program! Have you applied to Weber State University (may be done online at weber.edu) Is your college/university overall cumulative GPA at least 3.0? To be eligible to apply, you must be able to check all support courses from the one of the two Track options listed below, showing you have completed the courses with a grade of 'C' or higher. All courses within the required support course must be completed or in progress prior to starting the Occupational Therapy Assistant program: Track I OR Track II ___ Medical Terminology (HTHS 1101) Medical Terminology (HTHS 1101) Int. Anat/Phy II (HTHS 1111) ENGL 1010 (3) and 2010 (3) ENGL 1010 (3) and 2010 (3) To be eligible to apply, you must complete the following courses with a grade of 'B-'or higher. These courses must be completed prior to acceptance into the OTA program. RHS 2810/OTAB 1010 Introduction to Occupational Therapy (3) ZOOL 1610 Principles of Zoology (4) PSY 1010 Introductory Psychology (3) COMM 1020 Public Speaking (3) or COMM 2110 Interpersonal Communications (3) SOC 1010 Introduction to Sociology (3) or ANTH 1000 Introduction to Anthropology (3) CHF 1500 Human Development (3) RHS 1300 First Aid/CPR (3); RHS 2300 Emergency Response (3); Or EMT Certificate: PAR 1000 (4) and PAR 1001 (2) Math Quantitative Literacy Level Recommendation: http://www.weber.edu/placement/math.html We highly recommend that you meet the Math 1050 QL or Math 1080 QL requirement, but MATH 1040 QL will be accepted. Higher level QL's could be prerequisites for many graduate/pre-professional programs. ACT Math Score of 23 or higher. Accuplacer College Level Math (CLM) core of 50 or higher within the last year (Be aware that certain graduate programs may require a Math grade or other courses past Math 1050 OL.)

Pre-Occupational Therapy

This graduate program requirements can vary extremely depending on the school you are working towards applying to. Please plan and research accordingly.

Pre-Med

MATH* (1050 QL + 1060) or 1080 QL Some schools may require MATH 1210 Calculus CHEM 1200 CHEM 1210 PS*, 1220*, 2310*, & 3070* MICR 2054 LS*, 3254*, & 3305* PHYS 2010 PS* and PHYS 2020* ZOOL 1110 LS*, 3200*, & 3300* PSY 3010* and PSY 3600* Suggested: HTHS 2230, 3240, and SOC 1010

The most important thing is to find **8-10 professional schools** you interested in, see what they require and work backwards. Make yourself an amazing applicant for those schools rather than being a good applicant for many.

We recommend that students job shadow in preparation for an OTA or OTR (graduate) program. Students will complete 6 job shadow hours in RHS 2810/OTAB 1010 course. Some graduate programs require 75-3000+ job shadow hours. It is important to know what your preferred programs require. Each program will have their own requirements.
