## The MAIN verb of a sentence will NEVER do the following:

- Never be part of a prepositional phrase. The subject won't be in there either.



- Never be in the "to" form. to run, to jump. To be or not to be a verb? NOT!



- Never end with an **–ing** *alone*. A helping verb must come **before** the **"ing**."
