Notes for the Current (2023-2024) faculty numbers for apportionment:

- Overall there was a 1-3 increase in number of full-time faculty in all Colleges
 - The exception to the increase was Arts and Humanities who currently have 4-5 faculty positions open.
- Total number of faculty increased from 581 to 591.5.
- The total number of faculty seats is static @ 39 and do not change with the increase in number.
- Instead, the faculty seats are redistributed evenly using the above formula: base seats + remainder sorted= total seats per college.

Overall Apportionment Changes:

- Arts and Humanities lost 1; numbers changed from 118 (2022-2023) to 113 (2023-2024)
- Education gained 1: numbers changed from 50 (2022-2023) to 55 (2023-2024)
