\_\_\_\_\_ To be eligible to apply, you must be able to check **all** support courses from the one of the two Track options listed below, showing you have completed the courses with a grade of **'C' or higher**. *All courses within the required support course must be completed or in progress prior to starting the Rehabilitation Sciences program:*

- \_\_\_\_ RHS 2175 Introduction to Sports Medicine (3)
- \_\_\_\_ RHS 2890 Introduction to Cooperative Work Experience (1) Please see <u>Weber.edu/athletic-training/rhsinternships</u> for info & how to register
- \_\_\_\_ RHS 1300 First Aid/CPR (2) or RHS 2300 (3) Emergency Response;
  - Or EMT Certificate: PAR 1000 (4) and PAR 1001 (2)

\*\*Selection should be based on your pre-professional graduate program of interest.

- \_\_\_\_ Math Quantitative Literacy Level Recommendation:
  - We highly recommend that you meet the **Math 1050 QL** or **Math 1080 QL** requirement. Both are prerequisite options for many graduate/pre-professional programs. This option is determined by the graduate program you are seeking.
    - \_\_\_\_ ACT Math Score of 23 or higher.
      - (Be aware that certain graduate programs may require a Math grade or other courses past Math 1050 QL.)
